MEMORANDUM CALLING FOR RESEARCH

This internal communication is a call for research related to the implementation of the cyborg political candidate project, codenamed: iBelieve, aka Arnold. Our long-term goal is to be able to replicate actual candidates/dignitaries in insecure locales to mitigate threats.

Technology teams have made advances regarding the physical structure and integrity of Arnold, but are ready to upload new data sets in the form of a political profile based on an authentic party platform and related ideology.

Specifically, this research call relates to any party platform, but consistency and reliability are imperative. The profile must be in the form of data to upload. These profiles will be put through a battery of tests, including a series of debates and interviews. Arnold must be able to answer specific questions (such as those at a news conference) and engage for at least three minutes with a person expressing opposing viewpoints.

Teams should consider using Value Tensions as a guide. Direct questions to your team facilitator. Profiles are due to your team facilitator by October 19.
